WV MediWeb Portal

- Provides access to patient pharmacy and medical history (*emergency room visits, out-patient visits, in-patient hospital visits, diagnosis history and medication history*)
- Provides capability to submit drug prior authorization requests electronically with Smart Forms (*reduces repetitive entering of demographic information*)
- Provides access to free ePrescribing software (*can be used for all patients*)

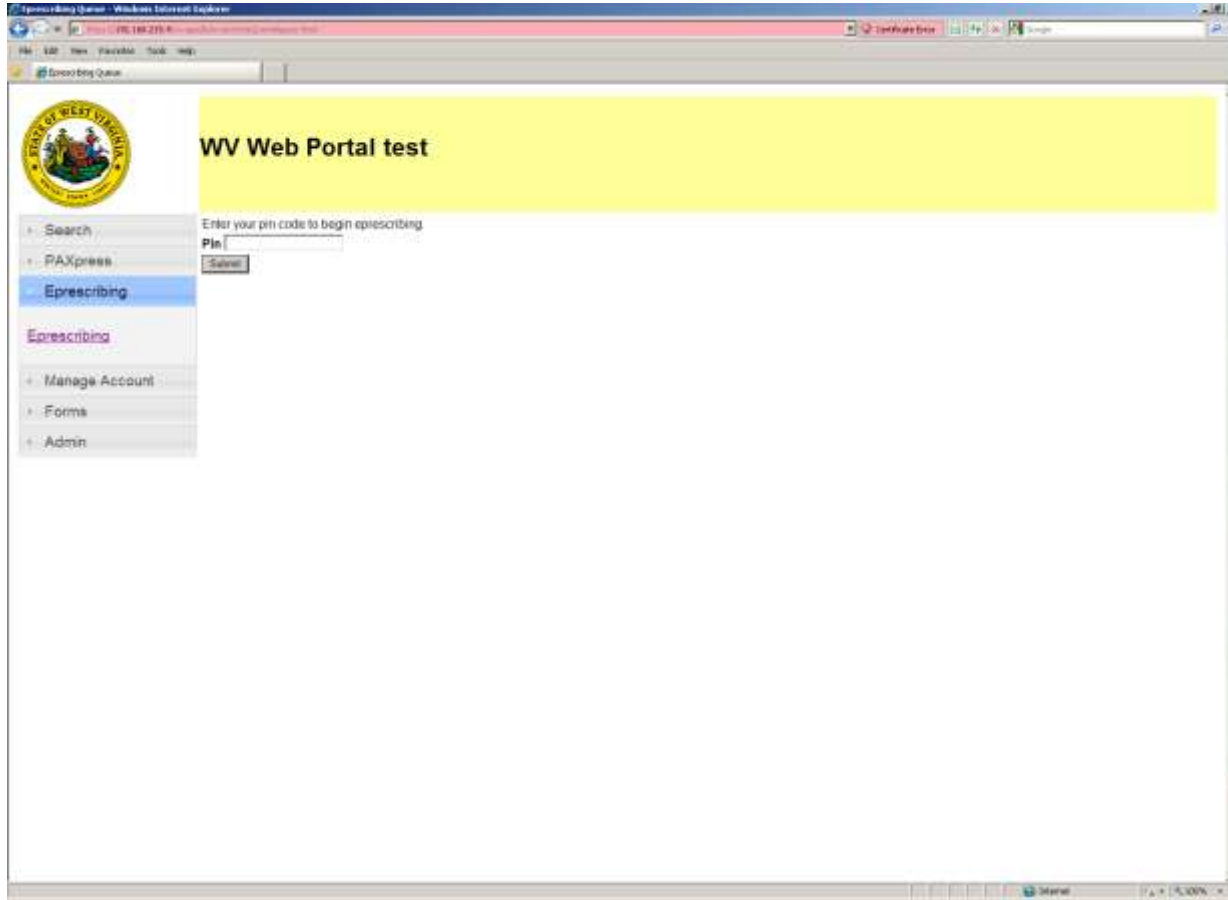

ePrescribing

- Brings patient information to the physician instantly
 - Prospective review (therapeutic and ingredient duplications, dosing information, drug-drug and drug-disease interactions)
 - Patient history
 - Compliance review
- Allows immediate response and prescribing changes if necessary
- Eliminates the need for a review of individual insurance formularies
- Eliminates transcription errors

There's more.....

- Eliminates phone calls from pharmacists to relay prescription conflicts
- Provides opportunity for prescribing changes real-time
- Insures that the patient gets medication prescribed without delays
- Reduces transcription errors
- Reduces duplications of therapy and adverse drug interactions

And more.....

- Reduction in complications due to prescribing errors - most are caused by lack of coordination of medication therapy
(IF patients don't tell you, there may be no way of knowing they are already taking a beta blocker, a diuretic and an ACE inhibitor)
- Reduction in number of prescriptions per patient
(Early studies show an average of 1.2/patient)
- Reduction in pharmacy and medical treatment costs

And last but not least....

Did you know that Medicare encourages ePrescribing by offering:

Incentive payments based on medical claims submitted

2009-2010 - 2% of eligible professional services

2011-2012 -1% of eligible professional services

2013 - 0.5% of eligible professional services

2012-Penalty** -1% of eligible professional services**

2013-Penalty**-1.5% of eligible professional services**

2014 and subsequent years – **Penalty of 2%**

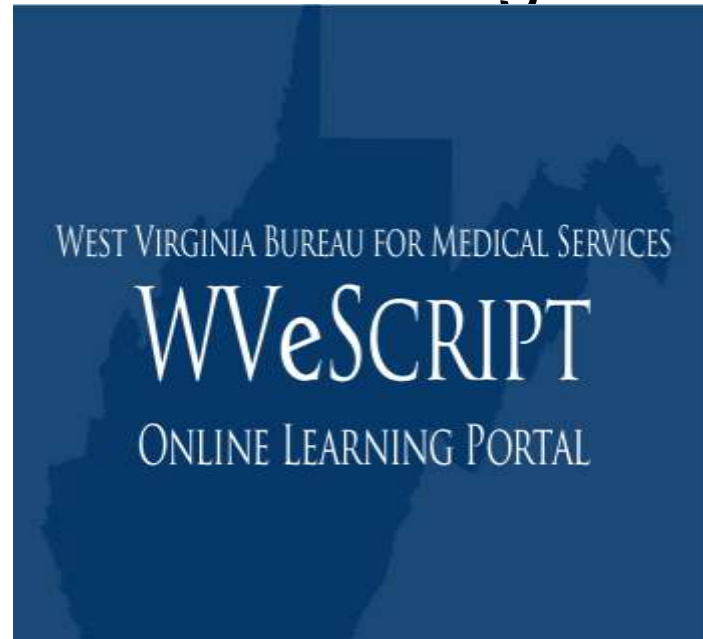
